## **Fellowship 2gether: “cultivating a life in common”**

(1Cor 1:10) p. 14 “He doesn’t just love you; he loves everyone else just as much...” God loved Mother Theresa, Gandhi, Martin Luther and John Wesley. God loved Hitler, Genghis Khan, and the Unabomber. Where do we fit in the picture? My parents love each of their daughters. Yet, we feel a drive to compete for the love we already have. Somehow we thought that we could make them love us more, approve of us more. We didn’t realize that unconditional love is already infinite and therefore there is no real concept of more or less. That kind of love just is. If we try to compete or earn more of this love, we are trying to contain it or control it. That would just diminish what it is.

We are grown-ups now. Accepting unconditional love will change every aspect of our lives. Instead of looking for that part of a disagreeable person that is deserving of love, we will look for God’s love working for that person. Our fellowship together needs to be based on that spark; it is the only thing to really build a relationship on.

Dr. M. Scott Peck is author of such books as The Road Less Traveled, and The Different Drum, and he has also designed community building workshops that were popular in the 80’s. He has some interesting insights into the question, “What is Community?” (These quotes are taken from The Different Drum book on tape)

“It is quite natural for community to develop in times of crisis. And so it is in the waiting room of an intensive care ward, strangers will quite rapidly start talking to one another about their deepest fears and hopes as their relatives lie across the hall on the critical list. ...the problem is as soon as the crisis passes so does the community.”

## **Serve 2gether: “working 2gether with 1 heart & 1 purpose”**

(Phil 2:2) God always acts first. This is one of those statements you either believe or don't. You could spend your life trying to prove or disprove it and end up with just a spent life.
